## **Arkansas Department of Education**

*Children who enter school with a range of skills and knowledge tend to be more successful in school. While mastery of any or all of the skills identified is not required for admission to kindergarten, these indicators will help children enter kindergarten with confidence.*

### ***Expressive/Receptive Language Comprehension***

- 1. Uses effective oral communication skills and speaks in complete sentences
- 2. Understands and follows directions with at least two steps
- 3. Understands vocabulary related to position, direction, size and comparison
  - like/different
  - top/bottom
  - first/last
  - big/little
  - up/down
- 4. Makes simple predictions and comments about a story being read

### ***Approach To Learning/Cognition***

- 5. Demonstrates visual discrimination skills by matching two like pictures in a set of five pictures
- 6. Classifies (same/different, alike/not alike) objects by physical features
  - shape
  - color
  - size
- 7. Classifies objects conceptually (things that go together)
- 8. Recognizes, replicates or repeats patterning sequence
- 9. Demonstrates the ability to correctly put in order or sequence up to three (3) story pictures
- 10. Recites/participates/joins in repeating a familiar song/poem/finger play/nursery rhyme
- 11. Retells a simple story after listening to a story with pictures
- 12. Works simple puzzles (up to four 4 pieces)
- 13. Identifies/points to five (5) colors

### ***Phonological Awareness/Print Knowledge***

- 14. Recognizes name in print when shown word cards
- 15. Points to and/or recognizes letters in name
- 16. Attempts to write letters in own name
- 17. Recognizes environmental print or familiar signs in the child's environment
- 18. Demonstrates book awareness

## North Little Rock Montessori Summer Care Agreement 2010

1. There is a \$25.00 nonrefundable registration fee per child. This is due at the time of registration to hold a place for your child in our program.
2. Fees are payable at the beginning of each week of care, unless other arrangements have been made. Late fees will be assessed at \$1.00 per day after that. There is also a \$25.00 returned check charge on any items not paid by your bank. Please be prompt in paying your tuition.
3. Summer care hours are from 7:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. each day. A late fee of \$1.00 per minute will be charged for anyone picked up after 6:00 p.m. THIS FEE WILL BE DUE AT THE TIME OF PICK UP.
4. Please remember to pack healthy and balanced lunches and two snacks (no candy) for your children. We provide drinks at snack time, unless you prefer to send a drink. We care about the nutritional needs of your children and know that they will feel better physiologically when they eat well. Also, milk is available for purchase at \$0.75 per day.
5. We have pizza day on Fridays. For \$2.50 you may purchase 2 items (any combination) of a super slice of pizza (1/4 of a medium pizza), or an order of crazy bread. Pizza choices include cheese, pepperoni, and beef. Order forms will be available on Mondays, and will be due (with payment) no later than Thursday afternoons.
6. We also offer the option of purchasing your child's snack at \$1.25 each. We provide the drinks, or you may choose to send your own. Should your child not have a snack at snack time, we will provide one for them and these fees will be added to your account at \$1.25 per snack. Please remind your little ones to save their snacks (or you may label it- some parents have elected to put a sign, such as a star, on the snack so that their child knows not to eat that item at lunch time). We have had students eat their snacks at lunch and then have nothing left for snack later!
7. If your child will nap during the day (children 4 and under), please send a light blanket, pillow, and a small lovey (optional) for them. Bedding items will be sent home at the end of each week for cleaning.
8. If someone other than a parent will be picking up a child, we **MUST** have written notification. In addition, the responsible party will need to have a picture ID available upon request.
9. The children will have the same rules and discipline policies that our program uses during the school year. This is one of kindness and respect towards others, teachers as well as peers.
10. Children may bring their own toys from home **on Wednesdays only**. Please use good judgment and do not allow your child to bring toys that would be violent in nature (guns, war toys, etc.) or otherwise unacceptable at our school. Note: Though we will make our best effort to ensure that things get returned home in the state they were brought to us, we will not be held responsible for damages, etc., for items that your child brings.
11. Each family must supply sunscreen (to be kept at the center) for use when your child/children are outside. **Please clearly label this with his/her name, as well as any other items your child brings to summer care.**
12. We must have two weeks written notice should you choose to withdraw your child from care. You will be charged for those two weeks whether your child attends or not.
13. At North Little Rock Montessori School, we recognize and value the importance of family. To promote devoting time and care to your children, our program allows each family to take one week (5 weekdays) of vacation during the summer months without charge. However, parents must specify dates at least two weeks in advance.
14. Children should be dressed in clothing that will accommodate all kinds of play and sensorial experiences. We ask that you also provide your child with a full change of clothing to be kept here at the school. This should be clearly

labeled, preferably in a small storage container. Even older children occasionally have accidents of one sort or another. In addition, we will have water play outside (weather permitting) on Tuesday and Thursday mornings. If your child chooses to participate in this, they will need a bathing suit, water shoes, and a towel.

15. Please ensure that your child has eaten a well-balanced breakfast **before** arriving in the mornings.

16. Students entering third grade and up may participate in off-campus field trips only with signed parental permission slips. Any fees required for field trips must be paid for in advance. These spaces are limited (due to transportation constraints), and the children will be rotated out, depending on numbers/interest level. We will continue to have guest speakers and other engaging activities for those students who do not participate in off-campus field trips.

**There may be small fees associated with our on-site field trips. If you would like your child to participate, please make sure to fill out permission slips and send payment in advance.**
